There has been lots of wildlife themed excitement in Early Years this week. On Monday we discovered that the giant eggs had disappeared from the classroom. We visited the nature garden again later in the week to release our butterflies, after a few days of observing them.

We have been amazed by the knowledge the children have about wildlife. They have been sharing facts in conversation, drawing and writing. In maths, we have been exploring capacity and finding out how much water different containers can hold.
