The children made an exciting discovery in the courtyard this week, finding two enormous eggs! After some talk about not taking eggs from nests in the wild, we decided that these eggs were a little different and needed to be looked after. They have spent the week making predictions about what might hatch from them, using non-fiction books to try and identify the eggs, and thinking about how to take care of them. Many of the children have also made posters to share their ideas for keeping the eggs safe. We're excited to see if they hatch over the weekend!

The children have met their Y1 teachers, sharing a story with them on Wednesday. There will be many other transition activities happening over the next few weeks, including an opportunity for you to meet your child's new teacher (see Diary Dates).

In maths, we have been estimating amounts and counting to see how close we were with our 'sensible guess'.
