We have been learning about time in maths. This is a topic some children feel more confident in than others. To help continue this area of their learning, it would be really helpful for them to wear a wristwatch (analogue rather than digital). In year 2, children are expected to be able to tell the time to the nearest o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past. Some children will be able to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes, but that is not needed to be at

year 2 level. We encourage you to check in with your child's knowledge of time through consistent practise at home, this will help them feel more confident.
