Nursery are focusing a lot of their learning around the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. They will also create some transient art using sticks, stones and other natural objects.

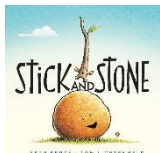

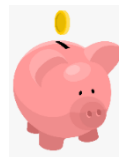
Stay and Play:
